

## 2. Kerala: Snehaveedu (House Construction for the Homeless)

NSS volunteers in Kerala actively constructed houses for economically weaker sections under the *Snehaveedu* project.

- **Volunteer Engagement & Scope:** This was a massive volunteer effort involving 95,304 NSS Volunteers.

**Impact:** Altogether, 205 houses were constructed and distributed to beneficiaries. Specifically, 132 houses were completed under M.G. University NSS, and around 72 houses were constructed by NSS volunteers from other institutions.

NSS volunteers constructed houses for economically weaker sections. Under M.G. University NSS, **132 houses were completed**. A new home was gifted to **Smt. Damayanthi** by the SN Trust School NSS Unit, Nattika. In addition, NSS volunteers from other institutions have constructed **around 72 houses** under the *Snehaveedu* project. **Altogether, 205 houses were constructed and distributed** to beneficiaries. 95,304 NSS Volunteers were actively involved in the programme.
