एकजीलियम महिला कॉलेज में हुआ स्तन कैंसर के प्रति जागरूकता कार्यक्रम



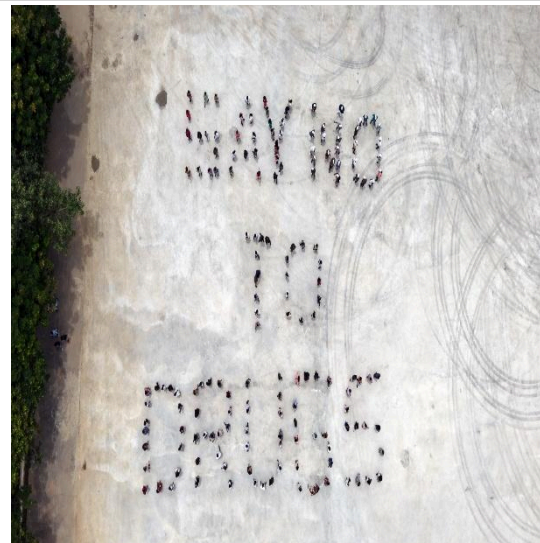
